In preparation for the written exam:

- Sessions on tips, tricks and structures for each question type

- Rapid-fire 'two-minute mindset' and 'synthesis and structure' drills
- 'Horror hot cases' session to prepare you for those tricky cases
- Simulated and real hot case practice with expert feedback

In preparation for the vivas:

- 'pause and discuss' vivas
- 'millionaire hot seat' vivas
- Vivas under exam conditions
- Knowledge, radiology and practical stations
- Communication stations with professional actors

You will be put through your paces before, during and after the course to help keep you on track.
