

Senior Staff Specialist or Staff Specialist (Intensivist)

Wide Bay Hospital and Health Service is looking to recruit a Senior Staff Specialist or Staff Specialist (Intensivist) to join our current team at Hervey Bay Hospital.

Hervey Bay Hospital Intensive Care Unit is a mixed adult CICM Level 2 unit, is currently a 8 bed unit increasing to a 12 bed unit after construction of a new ICU in the near future. Patients requiring mechanical ventilation, renal replacement therapy and invasive cardiovascular monitoring are managed at Hervey Bay ICU.

The ICU admits approximately 500 patients per annum with almost half of those patients requiring ventilation. The Hervey Bay Hospital Intensive/Coronary Care Unit supports a range of services for the community including General Medical, Renal, General Surgical, Obstetrics, Paediatrics and Oncology.

Hervey Bay Hospital is the acute facility on the Fraser Coast and works in close partnership with Maryborough Hospital to deliver high quality health care to the community. Hervey Bay Hospital is currently undergoing a major multi million dollar upgrade including an expanded Emergency Department, ICU and Education Centre.

A broad range of health care services are available including acute inpatient and outpatient services, community health, oral health and community mental health services, some of which are provided at off campus sites including 'The Village'.

Since it opened in 1997, Hervey Bay Hospital has built a reputation for excellence especially in professional education and attracts medical and nursing programs in conjunction with a number of renowned Queensland Universities.

The Fraser Coast is one of the most rapidly growing regional centres in Queensland with Hervey Bay listed as one of Queensland's best natural holiday destinations.
