Albury Wodonga Health are seeking an Intensive Care Specialist to join our team in providing quality care to patients from the region. Fellows of the College of Intensive Care Medicine of Australia and New Zealand are invited to apply.

Albury Wodonga Health is a 280 bed service over two hospitals in Albury and Wodonga respectively. Our major acute site is Albury Hospital, where our intensive care unit is located. Our services include emergency, general medicine, general surgery, orthopaedics, ophthalmology, urology, paediatrics, obstetrics & gynaecology, and cancer services.

Our critical care service comprises a level 2 10 bed unit with a capacity for 5 ventilated beds and attends to well over 300 ventilated patients a year. There are currently four consultants, an overnight ICU registrar, and daytime HMO cover.

We have ability to perform continuous renal replacement therapies and plasmapheresis. An on-site cardiac catheterisation suite is currently under construction and expected to be fully functional in 2018. Recent construction of a co-located Cancer Centre is now complete. The service contributes regularly to the ANZICS data base and is involved in ANZICS CTG clinical trials.

Our Region

Albury Wodonga is a bustling community of 100,000 located on the Hume Highway between Melbourne and Sydney. The cities serve as the base for a larger regional population and have a vibrant and diverse range of businesses and services. Our size and role in North East Victoria and Southern New South Wales ensures that we are well serviced with a wealth of high quality educational institutions, medical and health facilities, great shopping and a full range of service providers. The region offers over 1,700 child care places, 32 pre-schools, 50 primary schools, 24 secondary schools, two universities and two TAFEs.
