Royal Perth Hospital is looking for a full time Senior Registrar or experienced Registrar from July/August 2017 or earlier for the remainder of the year, though shorter time frames may be possible by negotiation.

The Intensive Care Unit is a 20 bed busy, dynamic unit caring for the most acutely ill patients who have been referred to us from across Western Australia with approximately 1500 admissions each year. Our staff members have broad experience in managing patients with all types of acute medical and surgical illnesses.

Our specialty areas include:

- major trauma including neuro-trauma
- complex and elective surgery, and
- complex spinal surgery including scoliosis surgery

The ICU Senior Registrar rosters cover 24 hours a day, 7 days a week including oncall. In collaboration with other team members, you will provide clinical management and care to our patients, under the guidance and supervision of the hospital's ICU Consultants.

Essential Criteria

- Current general registration with the Medical Board of Australia (AHPRA);
- A minimum of three years relevant clinical experience;
- Appointment at Senior Registrar level requires at least 24 months recent experience in Intensive Care or successful completion of the examination for Fellowship of the College of Intensive Care Medicine or equivalent qualification.
- Resuscitation skills, including airways management and vascular access.
