

Hospital Medical Officers - ICU

The Position

An exciting opportunity exists for Hospital Medical Officers to join our Intensive Care Unit (ICU). The ICU at the Sunshine Coast University Private Hospital is a Level 5 Intensive Care. The unit comprises of 8 ICU beds, 3 of which are dedicated CCU beds. The unit has 24 hours presence of a Resident Medical Officer and is supervised by an Intensive Care Specialist who is always contactable.

The source of our admissions is widespread and includes “in-house” elective and emergency admissions from the wards, operating suites, and transfers from public emergency departments. Predominantly our admissions are post-operative general surgery. We can ventilate indefinitely, dialyse, plasmaphereses and provide cardiovascular support, including IABP, as required.

We have permanent and casual positional available but you must be available to work a minimum of 48 hours per fortnight. The Hospital Medical Officer roster operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with shifts 12 hours long including the following:

Day Shift - 08:00 – 20:30

Night Shift - 20:00 – 8:30

This is a great opportunity to use your clinical assessment and diagnostic skills within a supportive, collegial environment. These positions would ideally suit medical officers seeking a flexible work arrangement allowing time to undertake further study or to spend time with family.

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA:

- Only candidates holding full general registration with AHPRA to apply
- A minimum of 3 years Australian clinical experience
- Required to be PGY3+ and have greater than 6 months ICU and/or anaesthetics experience.
