

Position Title: Medical Practitioner / Doctor (Clinical Commander)

Purpose: To assist in the provision of onsite First Aid and Emergency Clinical Services for the public at various high-risk events throughout Australia.

Responsibility: This role is responsible for the following outcomes / criteria -:

- Assessment and diagnosis of patients
- Organise and/or provide treatment, including procedures where appropriate and within the practitioner's skill set
- Advising and/or directing other team members as appropriate
- Liaison with ambulance services and hospitals to effect the safe and timely transfer of patients to these other services
- Oversee, monitor and provide guidance with the clinical care provided by other team members
- Report and discuss any serious concerns with the Event Commander

NOTE

- The medical practitioner is not expected to personally assess and treat every patient that comes to the medical station
- Patients may include event patrons, staff and contractors, and anyone else who may present requiring care. Duty of Care is not limited by the client's expectations.
- Notwithstanding the medical practitioners' ultimate responsibility to their patients, they should appreciate that they are part of an inter-dependent team. This may be more so than in their usual practice within a hospital setting. It should also be recognised that in remote locations, not all the facilities of a city hospital are available so that sometimes adaptation and compromise may be necessary.

- Provide PBS Doctors bag and suturing kit
