Registrar Positions in PICU – Opportunities from February 2018 and August 2018

About the Role

An exciting opportunity exists for experienced trainees in Anaesthesia, Paediatric Intensive Care, General Intensive Care and Paediatric Emergency Medicine to apply for the new position of Registrar in PICU at Monash Health.

Monash Health has commissioned the new Monash Children's Hospital and will open the dedicated 10-bed Monash Paediatric Intensive Care Unit from February 2018. The Monash PICU will be one of only two paediatric intensive care units in Victoria and provide a broad range of general paediatric, subspecialty paediatric and paediatric surgical intensive care.

The Monash PICU Registrar positions would suit trainees with established skills in advanced life-support who seek to broaden their experience in paediatric critical care:

- PICU trainees
- Advanced Anaesthesia registrars/fellows
- Experienced Adult ICU registrars/fellows
- Experienced Paediatric Emergency Medicine registrars/fellows

In addition to the interesting and challenging clinical work under the guidance of a dedicated team of PICU consultants in a new tertiary paediatric ICU, the Monash PICU will provide a structured teaching program including access to the Monash Paediatric BASIC course, complemented by daily teaching ward rounds. You will also have the opportunity to attend teaching sessions in the Monash Medical Centre Adult ICU as well as monthly VICEN training sessions. The Monash Critical Care Service has an active research unit which will give you the option to participate in both CTG and unit-based research.

Positions are offered as fixed term 6 or 12-month appointments commencing in February 2018 and August 2018. Applicants must hold current registration with AHPRA.

The Monash PICU is accredited for training by the College of Intensive Care Medicine of Australia and New Zealand (CICM).
