New Positions beginning Feb 2018

The Intensive Care Unit at the Sydney Adventist Hospital (the San) provides an exciting opportunity to work in a new unit with first-class facilities and a great team of medical, nursing and allied health staff.

The San is a tertiary referral hospital and is the largest private, not-for-profit hospital in NSW, working closely with public hospitals, including Westmead and Royal North Shore hospitals. The hospital has recently been extensively redeveloped, and now is a facility with 550 beds and 24 operating theatres. A state-of-the-art 30 bed ICU unit was opened in August 2015.

This unit is accredited for C6 training with the College of Intensive Care Medicine (CICM).

Trainees work alongside Senior ICU CMOs and intensivists with strong links to RNS, and you will be provided with the opportunity to see a diverse and interesting mix of cases, including emergency and elective cardiothoracic and neurosurgical patients; and acute medical patients admitted via the Emergency Department. A combined rotation to the ICU at North Shore Private Hospital may be possible.

Registrar applicants must be AHPRA registered (or ability to be registered), at least 3 years post-graduation with at least 6 months' ICU experience. Registrar salary and conditions are in accordance with the Public Hospital Medical Officers (State) Award.
