The SCUPH, located at Kawana on Queensland's Sunshine Coast is part of the Ramsay Health Care network of hospital. The hospital is a new 200 bed private hospital, providing a wide range of surgical and medical services. From December 2013 to mid-2018, the SCUPH will treat public patients under contract with Queensland Health and you will be required to manage public and private admitted patients, in collaboration with other team members, under the guidance of the Visiting Medical Specialists.

Facilities include 6 state-of-the-art operating theatres, a cardiac catheter laboratory, a minor procedure room, a day surgery unit, an 8 bed intensive care unit and an 8 chair day oncology unit. Medical consulting suites are located onsite together with comprehensive pathology and radiology services. Other onsite facilities include a retail pharmacy and coffee shop.

The Sunshine Coast University Private Hospital (SCUPH), has opportunities for Resident Medical Officers interested in joining our existing pool of doctors and providing clinical management and care for a wide range of Hospital inpatients.

The medical officer roster operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with shifts of 8-12 hours long.
