Sydney Adventist Hospital (the San) provides an exciting opportunity to work in a new Intensive Care Unit with first-class facilities and a great team of medical, nursing and allied health staff.

The San is a tertiary referral hospital and is the largest private, not-for-profit hospital in NSW, working closely with public hospitals, including Royal North Shore Hospital. The hospital has recently been extensively redeveloped, and now is a facility with 550 beds and 24 operating theatres and a state-of-the-art ICU of 30 beds.

This unit is accredited for C6 training with the College of Intensive Care Medicine (CICM).

You will be working alongside intensivists with strong links to RNS, and you will be provided with the opportunity to see a diverse and interesting mix of cases, including emergency and elective cardiothoracic and neurosurgical patients and acute medical patients admitted via the Emergency Department. A combined rotation to the ICU at North Shore Private Hospital may be possible.

Applicants must be at least 3 years post-graduation with at least 6 months' ICU experience.
