ONLINE ASSESSMENTS

Online In-Training Evaluation Reports (ITER) are now available for trainees and supervisors.

The new online In-Training Evaluation Report (ITER) is now available via the Education link in the Member's Portal. The online ITER form replaces the paper-based In-Training Assessments (ITA). The paper ITA forms will gradually be replaced by the online ITER in 2014.

The information required for the ITER (supervisor name and email address) comes from your trainee's prospective Applications for Vocational Training (AVT). Please check your details are correct when signing an AVT to ensure you receive all the relevant ITER information. It is important to remember to only sign an AVT for a term that you will be evaluating.

OBSERVING EXAMS

The College encourages Supervisors to attend First Part, Second Part and Paediatric Second Part examinations as observers when possible. For Supervisors, observing examinations can help improve guidance to trainees and provides greater awareness of examination procedures.
