RULES FOR OBSERVERS AT EXAMINATIONS WHO ARE NOT MEMBERS OF THE PANEL OF EXAMINERS

1. Observers may attend only with the permission of the Chair of the Court of Examiners or the Deputy Chair.
2. Each Observer will make his presence known to the Chair or Deputy Chair before attending any section of the examination.
3. There shall be only one Observer to any candidate at the one time.
4. Observers must not approach or leave an examination table during the conduct of an individual examination.
5. Observers are to remain well away from the examination table and the candidate, and to sit in a position at the discretion of the Chair of the Court of Examiners.
6. Observers must retire during the Examiners' discussion on the performance of any of the candidates.
7. No written notes are to be taken during the progress of the oral examination, and the content must be kept absolutely confidential.
8. Silence must be strictly observed.
9. A copy of these rules must be available for all Observers to read.
