### BE AN INTENSIVE CARE REGISTRAR IN THE NT

### AT THE ROYAL DARWIN HOSPITAL from February 2019

Royal Darwin Hospital (RDH) ICU is recruiting ICU registrars and a senior registrar/Fellow for 2019

The RDH Intensive Care Unit (ICU) provides critical care to the Top End NT (population 180,000), and also the Kimberley Region from Kununurra to Broome. RDH is the forward receiving hospital for Northern Australia and plays a major role in disaster management in the region through the National Critical Care & Trauma Response Centre (NCCTRC).

RDH ICU is a mixed Adult/Paediatric Level 3 ICU with 18 beds. In addition to paediatrics, the case mix includes sepsis, trauma, and neurosurgery. Cardiac Surgical Services are scheduled to start in 2019. In 2017 there were 1250 admissions. The ICU Department employs 8 ICU Specialists, 1 ICU Fellow, 5 ICU registrars and 5 ICU RMOs.

The registrar role, suitable for PGY 3-4 CICM, ANZCA or ACEM trainees, will provide those with aptitude the opportunity to complete 12 months as ICU registrar and 12 months acute general medicine. 100% of candidates who have sat the CICM Primary while at RDH have passed. Successful candidates will have the opportunity to apply for 12 months anaesthesia training.

ICU Senior registrar role is suitable for CICM, ANZCA advanced trainees within 2 years of completing their training programme. Fellow positions are for post CICM fellowship exam trainees. In addition to clinical skills, there will be the opportunity to participate in teaching and research.
