The Package

Full time (80 hours per fortnight) salary as per WA Health System Medical Practitioners AMA Industrial Agreement 2016:

Registrar Year 1-7, \$130,145 to \$174,823 pa*

* includes base salary \$109,678 to \$150,479 pa, professional Development allowance \$10,048 pa and 9.50% employer contributed Superannuation. Rates as at October 2018.

In addition (in line with operational requirements), access to salary packaging up to \$19,000 pa, professional development opportunities and study leave/assistance may apply.

Shift and after hours penalties are additional to this package.

The Role

4 Registrars (trainees / service) 12 months positions for Intensive care, Bunbury Health Campus

1 Registrar: CICM Trainee: 12 months position with 6 months rotation in Anaesthetics in Bunbury Health Campus

The Specialist Training Program (STP) is available to an ICU trainee registered with College of Intensive Care Medicine (CICM) of Australia and New Zealand. The position offers 6 months experience in Critical Care Medicine and a guaranteed 6 months of accredited training time in Anaesthesia.

Applicants must have a minimum of 6 months experience in Critical Care Medicine at a registrar level (Emergency; ICU or Anaesthetics), with a preference for candidates who have experience from Australia or a recognised competent authority country (United Kingdom, Canada, United States, New Zealand and Ireland).

Bunbury Hospital is accredited for Australian Medical Council Work-based Assessment (WBA) for eligible applicants, however hospital based rotations in general medicine, surgery and emergency medicine for full general registration is not a component of this post and cannot be subsequently guaranteed

The successful candidates will be responsible for the clinical care of patients under the supervision of senior medical staff including: attending to patients in order of medical urgency; taking history, full medical examinations of new admissions and arranging appropriate investigations and assisting with medical procedures as required; managing medical conditions according to acceptable clinical standards under supervision of consultants; collaborating with other Medical, Nursing staff and multidisciplinary team members to facilitate patient management; and communication with family concerning patient management. The ICU Trainee will also work with Consultants in the efficient delivery of KPIs such as WEAT, timely discharge summaries and efficient discharge planning.

The Unit is a functional Level 2 unit with 8 beds ICU. We are presently providing invasive monitoring / cardio respiratory support and continuous renal replacement therapy. The department receives an average of 600 - 700 admissions every year. The unit will provide excellent exposure to medical and surgical critically ill patients and exposure to all procedures in intensive care unit. The unit has a 5 Registrar and 3 Consultant Roster.

Includes education program (Consultant and registrar talks, Primary CICM preparation). One of the consultants is a Primary Examiner for CICM. Bunbury Health Campus is accredited for CICM Training unit (foundation training and rural training) and has an active education program.
