The Position

Albury Wodonga Health has an exciting opportunity for a Consultant Intensivist to join our critical care team. This role is ideally suited to someone with a sub-specialty interest in critical care echocardiography and the willingness and ability to participate in the development and delivery of this service at Albury Wodonga Health.

The role also involves supervision, education and training of junior medical staff.

Albury Wodonga Health is a 280 bed regional service over two acute campuses, supported by 140 senior medical staff across multiple specialties and excellent clinical teams.

Our critical care service comprises a Level 2 ten bed unit with capacity for five ventilated beds and attends to over 300 ventilated patients per year. We have the ability to perform continuous renal replacement therapies and plasmapheresis. An on-site cardiac catheterisation suite is also on-site as is a co-located cancer centre. The service contributes regularly to the ANZICS database and is involved in ANZICS CTG clinical trials.

Successful applicants will be required to complete appropriate paperwork for AWH to meet its credentialing obligations.

The Region

Albury Wodonga is a bustling community of over 100,000 located on the Hume Highway between Melbourne and Sydney. The cities serve as the base for a larger regional population and have a vibrant and diverse range of businesses and services.
