



**DIRECTOR OF INTENSIVE CARE**

Cabrini Malvern is a 508-bed acute care hospital offering a wide range of services including coronary care, day procedures, day oncology, emergency care, hospital-in-the-home, intensive care (ICU), maternity, paediatrics, and 24 hour access to sophisticated medical imaging and pathology.

The Intensive Care Unit is a Level 3 adult ICU with 12 beds. The ICU admits over 1400 patients per year, of whom more than 50% are mechanically ventilated. More than half of the casemix is surgical with up to 30% unplanned admissions. The unit is staffed by an experienced nursing staff, with a high proportion of Critical Care Registered Nurses, and all allied health services are available. The senior medical staff consists of salaried intensivists and visiting intensivists. The junior medical staff consists of advanced trainees in intensive care and registrars on rotation from public hospital anaesthetic and emergency departments. The ICU also provides extensive support to the wider hospital through consultation, ad-hoc admissions, referrals and a rapid response (MET) team.

**The role**

The Director of Intensive Care has overarching responsibility to lead, plan and co-ordinate the medical activities of Cabrini Malvern ICU.

**The responsibilities of the role include**

- To maintain a sustained commitment of service to the wider hospital
- To provide an excellent patient and family experience
- To lead and direct the ICU consultants, registrars and medical students in their duties within ICU and across the wider Hospital

- To maintain an active multidisciplinary clinical research program
- To foster high levels of multi-disciplinary staff engagement
- To responsibly use resources
