

Fellow in Critical Care Medicine (senior registrar equivalent)

This is an opportunity to work in a General Intensive Care Unit (GICU) in a quaternary medical centre in Jerusalem. Hadassah University Hospital is a 1000 bed hospital, linked to the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. It provides medical services to the Jerusalem area, but has a catchment area that extends as far as Moscow.

The critical care fellow will work in the GICU, a 14 bed ICU, which provides services to all the departments in the hospital, except paediatrics. It also deals with trauma patients and burns patients.

There is an active educational program in the unit and the hospital is a well-known research centre (it attracts 50% of the medical research funding in the country).

The fellow will work with junior trainees (residents) from anaesthesia and surgery and will be supervised by intensivists at all times. The roster is supportive of a healthy work-life balance. This position is open to trainees in critical care, who already have a base specialty such as anaesthesia, internal medicine or emergency medicine.
