The successful applicants will have a minimum of 6 months experience in Critical Care Medicine (Emergency; Acute Medicine; ICU or Anaesthetics), with a preference for candidates who have experience from Australia or a recognised competent authority country (United Kingdom, Canada, United States, New Zealand and Ireland). Candidates must be eligible for registration with APHRA.

The successful candidates will be responsible for the clinical care of patients under the supervision of senior medical staff including: participating in daily ward rounds and attending to patients in order of medical urgency; taking history of full medical examinations of new admissions and arranging appropriate investigations and assisting with medical procedures as required; managing medical conditions according to acceptable clinical standards under supervision of consultants; collaborating with other Medical, Nursing staff and multidisciplinary team members to facilitate patient management and communication with family, outside medical practitioners, and/or community services concerning patient management.
