The Monash Medical Centre Clayton Intensive Care Unit is a 26 bed tertiary referral unit, accredited with the College of Intensive Care Medicine (CICM) for General Training (Core Intensive Care /C24) as well as fulfilling the CICM requirements for subspecialty exposure to Cardiothoracic and Neurology/Neurosurgical Intensive Care. The Monash Medical Centre Intensive Care Unit also provides a state-wide Obstetric Intensive Care service, a Renal / Renal-Pancreas Transplant service and supports a comprehensive range of medical and surgical subspecialties.

We offer a highly stimulating and enjoyable clinical work environment, with an active and dynamic Intensivist led education program, including:
