Warringal Private Hospital is a 215 bed facility located 15 minutes from the CBD in Heidelberg. Services provided include Coronary Care and Interventional Cardiology, Cardiothoracic Surgery, General Surgery and Oncology. The hospital has 11 operating theatres, 2 cardiovascular interventional labs, 2 endoscopy procedure beds and an Intensive Care Unit.

The Intensive Care Unit has six ICU and six HDU beds. The Unit supports a full range of Critical Care Services including ECMO and renal replacement therapy. The ICU/HDU has over 1100 admissions a year, with a predominantly surgical case-mix including cardiothoracic and also medical patients. There is the opportunity to gain exposure to all modalities of ICU support and skills including echocardiography, ECMO and renal replacement therapy. There are six FCICM Intensivists working in the unit with a variety of clinical interests and skills who also provide services to The Austin Hospital. Opportunities exist to participate in research as part of the Austin Hospital ICU research program led by Professor Rinaldo Bellomo.

The position will support the Intensive Care Consultants with the provision of care during 12.5 hour shifts – (8am to 8.30pm and 8pm to 8.30am).

***Remuneration is well above public hospital award rates.***

Essential:

- Applicants must have a minimum of 2 years critical care experience (ICU, anaesthesia or emergency medicine) with at least 6 months intensive care experience.
- Applicants must have full general registration with the Australian Health Practitioners Regulatory Authority (AHPRA).
- FCICM/FANZCA/FACEM trainees are encouraged to apply.
