RULES FOR OBSERVERS AT EXAMINATIONS WHO ARE NOT MEMBERS OF THE PANEL OF EXAMINERS

- 1. Observers may attend only with the permission of the Chair of the Court of Examiners or the Deputy Chair.
- 2. Each Observer will make his presence known to the Chair or Deputy Chair before attending any section of the examination.
- 3. There shall be only one Observer to any candidate at the one time.
- 4. Observers must not approach or leave an examination table during the conduct of an individual examination.
- 5. Observers are to remain well away from the examination table and the candidate, and to sit in a position at the discretion of the Chair of the Court of Examiners.
- 6. Observers must retire during the Examiners' discussion on the performance of any of the candidates.
- 7. No written notes are to be taken during the progress of the oral examination, and the content must be kept absolutely confidential.
- 8. Silence must be strictly observed.
- 9. A copy of these rules must be available for all Observers to read.
